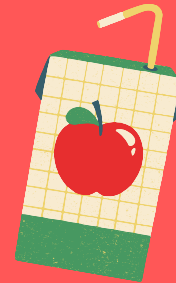




# Breakfast Program

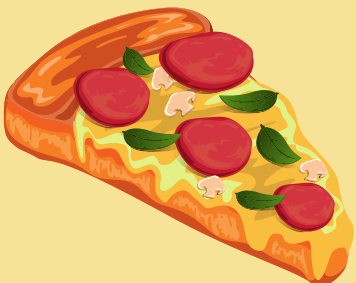
